# INTERNATIONAL STUDENT VILLAGE



The International Student Village will be the catalyst to attract an additional 1000 overseas international students a year to Canterbury to study at the region's tertiary

institutions. The central city Village will be established across two interconnected sites that will feature a balance of residential, teaching, commercial and open

space areas. The annual economic impact of the student village will add \$30 million plus and a significant number of jobs to the current tertiary international education

contribution to the region. Construction of the Village itself is a \$100 million project which will help catalyse Central City revitalisation.



## MISSION/VISION

The whole of life experience offered by the 'Christchurch International Student Village' is a key determinant of why international and out of region tertiary students select Christchurch as their study destination of choice. The Christchurch International Student Village offers a world class living and study experience to students of all nationalities and cultures thereby creating a sustainable business that provides substantial public good to the city.
